

2025 Residential Exterior Beautification Program

Stewartville Economic Development Authority

Program Intent

Stewartville's Economic Development Authority (EDA) was established to attract, promote, and develop an economically sound future for the City. The EDA continues to be a professional advocate for the business community; they provide ideas, information, financial packaging, and expertise in business development and retention. The EDA's objective is to make Stewartville an even better place to live, work, and do business.

The EDA established this program with the intention to enhance and improve the outward appearance of buildings and/or other areas of Stewartville's business districts. This program is designed to encourage the beautification of existing property exteriors and enhance the general character of commercial properties located in Stewartville; as such, improvements must be highly visible.

Program Funding

\$25,000 total has been designated for the program

The program will accept applications starting **January 6th**, **2025**. Applications will be reviewed in the order they were received. No applications will be accepted after **July 1st**, **2025**.

Match Requirement: 25% of total project cost

Minimum Grant Project: \$1,000

Applicants have the option to apply for one of the two project types included in the program.

Option 1 - Hired Contractors

- Up to \$5,000
- Requires two estimates of an equivalent project scope for project completion

Option 2 - DIY Projects

- Up to \$2,500
- Requires two material lists for the same project scope used for project completion

NO WORK MAY BEGIN PRIOR TO EDA APPROVAL

All projects **must** be completed with submitted invoices and completion photos on or before **December 31st, 2025.** Any projects not completed and/or submitted for reimbursement by that time will not be eligible for reimbursement irrespective of approval.

Eligible Properties & Projects

Eligible Properties:

- Existing single-family homes within Stewartville City Limits with county-assessed property values under \$ 250,000
- Eligible properties must be zoned residential
- Single-family homes within the business district are deemed eligible
- This program is only eligible for homeowners

Please note: Property must not have any outstanding obligations to the City (including delinquent payments or property taxes), applicant must own the property and project must have all required permits and approvals (if necessary).

Eligible Projects:

Projects must enhance and improve the aesthetics of the property.

Projects must be highly visible.

- Structure removal
- Garage door replacement
- Exterior lighting
- Power washing of building exterior
- Tree/Stump removal
- Painting of exterior including necessary scraping, repairing, and preparation for completion

- Decorative railing
- Landscaping rock
- Decorative fencing
- Front door replacement
- Permanant landscaping and green space
- Improvement of steps
- Decorative brick (on house)
- Siding
- Roofing work
- Window replacement

Application Process

1. Submission of Application

- All applications will be reviewed in the order they were received
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted
- Email your completed application and photos over to Sandra Drees at sdrees@stewartvillemn.com

2. Application Review

 The application will be reviewed by City staff and the EDA Finance Committee for recommendation to bring to the EDA Board

3. Application Decision

- Once the application has been given official recommendation, the application will be added to the agenda for the next EDA meeting
- EDA will approve or deny your application at the next scheduled meeting - it is recommended that you attend to present your project

4. Project Work

 Once the application is approved - you may now start work on the project

5. Reimbursement

- When the project is completed, you will need to provide the City with pictures of the completed project and a copy of the "Paid Invoice"
- Once you submit these items, Council will approve your reimbursement check at the next meeting
