


# Stewartville Precincts and Polling Locations

**RESOLUTION 2025- 11**

**A Resolution Designating Polling Places within the City of Stewartville**

Whereas, Minnesota Statutes 204B.16, subd. 1 requires municipalities to designate by ordinance or resolution any changes to a polling place location for each election precinct;

Whereas, this designation must be made by December 31 of each year for the following calendar year and beyond unless changed pursuant to statute; and

Whereas, the City of Stewartville elects to establish polling places by resolution;

Now Therefore be it Resolved, that that the following are established as polling places:

**Precinct 1:**

- Precinct Boundaries: Addresses South of E 1<sup>st</sup> St., South of W 1<sup>st</sup> St, and designations of N, NE & NW (See Mapping)
- Polling Place: Stewartville Civic Center, 120 City Center, Stewartville MN

**Precinct 2:**


- Precinct Boundaries: Addresses North of E 1<sup>st</sup> St, North of W 1<sup>st</sup> St. and designations of N, NE & NW (See Mapping)
- Polling Place: Stewartville American Legion 1100 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave NW, Stewartville MN

Be It Further Resolved, that these are the polling places for the year 2026 and beyond unless a change is made:

1. Due to an emergency pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 204B.175; or
2. Because a polling place has become unavailable; or
3. By a new resolution passed prior to December 31 of any year.
